Our website

This cookie policy relates to your use of our website.

Cookies

A cookie is a small text file which is placed onto your device (e.g. computer, smartphone or other electronic device) when you use our website. We use cookies on our website. These help us

- recognise you and your device and store some information about your preferences or past actions
- understand what you use and like about the website
- understand what you do not use and do not like about the website
- provide a more enjoyable, customises service and experience
- develop and deliver better products and services tailored to the interests and needs of our customers
- we may monitor how many times you visit the website, which pages you go to, traffic data, location data; and

Consent to use cookies and changing settings

We will ask for your permission (**Consent**) to place cookies or other similar technologies on your device, except where they are essential for us to provide you with a service that you have requested (e.g. to enable you to put items in your shopping basket and use our check-out process).

You can withdraw any consent to the use of cookies or manage any other cookie preferences by opting out on certain cookies. You have choices on how we use cookies. Please note that if you limit the ability of how we set cookies, you may worsen your overall user experience, since it may no longer be personalized to you. Our use of cookies

The table below provides more information about the cookies we use and why:

<p>PHP Server default cookie</p>	<p>PHPSESSID</p>	<p>Server default cookies are known as "sessions". The website in this case stores a single cookie on the browser containing a unique Session Identifier. The session Identifier is used to match the request with the data stored on the server. This cookie is used to store data such as: authentication data, user preferences, the content of a cart in an e-commerce website</p> <p>This cookie collects information in an anonymous form.</p> <p>Session cookies: These allow our website to link your actions during a particular browser session. These expire each time you close your browser and do not remain on your device afterwards.</p>	<p>Essential (we will therefore not request your consent before placing this cookie).</p>
<p>Age Verification</p>	<p>vapeJucceAge</p>	<p>This is an age verification service provided by Age Checked which uses cookies to prove someone is over 18, Whether or not a customer has been verified is then stored on our site so that each customer will only have to be verified once.</p> <p>This cookie collects information in an anonymous form unless the information provided during checkout is not sufficient to verify age, further data is then requested for the purposes of verifying age but this data is not stored.</p> <p>Session cookies: These allow our website to link your actions during a particular browser session. These expire each time you close your browser and do not remain on your device afterwards.</p> <p>Persistent cookies: These are stored on your device in between browser sessions. These allow your preferences or actions across our website to be remembered. These will remain in your device until after 24 hours of inactivity or you delete them from your cache.</p>	<p>Essential (we will therefore not request your consent before placing this cookie).</p>
